The Sight Word Efficiency (SWE) assesses the number of real printed words that can be accurately read within 45 second, and the Phonemic Decoding Efficiency (PDE) measures the number of printed nonwords that can be accurately decoded within the same time period.

WORDCHAINS (NFER)

A standardised, timed word-reading test that can be used to screen for SpLD and helps one to identify individual pupils with poor reading skills. It takes ten minutes to administer and gives a word recognition age, which can be used to check individual progress over time.

3. Mathematics

BASIC NUMBER SCREENING TEST

This test is designed to give a quick assessment of a child's understanding of number concepts and number skills. It takes 30-35 mins. To administer.

ESSENTIAL MENTAL MATHS and 2 TAPES

The Manual is divided into two parts: Part 1: Mental Maths Practice Tests

And answers. Part 2: Photocopiable answer grids.

Each test comprises 25 questions, which test mental arithmetic, estimation and knowledge of mathematical terms. In each test the questions fall into three different types, simple single calculations or mental recall; short step calculations and further computational skills required.

This is a written test assessing maths achievement. The 46 questions are open-ended and require constructed responses rather than recognition of correct answers in a multiple-choice test. 4. Manual Dexterity and Handwriting

This helps assess the extent to which individuals can integrate their visual and motor abilities. There is a core test and two supplementary tests of Visual Perception and Motor Coordination.

DETAILED ASSESSMENT OF SPEED OF HANDWRITING (DASH)

The assessment includes four subtests, each testing a different aspect of handwriting speed. In addition a supplementary test was administered to examine fine motor and precision skills

MORRISBY MANUAL DEXTERITY TESTS

This is a paper and pencil test that provides a measure of manual speed and skill. Easily administered in less than 5 minutes. There are two parts to the test. Part 1 involves hand and finger movements in which speed counts more highly than accuracy.

Part 2 involves hand and finger movements but accuracy is more important.
